Good Chews That Are Flexible and Help to Reduce Tartar Build Up:

Tartar Shield Chews
VeggieDent Chews
Kong Toys
Compressed Rawhide, Rawhide Chips/Strips
Rubber Balls
Healthy Edibles and Gumma Bone Nylabones
Jolly Balls
Greenies
Dentabones



Bad Chews That Are Too Hard and Can Fracture Teeth:

Knuckle Bones
Cooked or Cured/Smoked Bones
Antler
Hard Nylabones
Hooves
Pig Ears
Tennis Balls
Rawhide with knots
Bully Sticks
Tendon/Ligament Rawhides
